By car

Koningshof can easily be reached. Take exit 7 (Rijnsburg) on the A44 motorway (running from The Hague/Wassenaar to Amsterdam). In the town of Rijnsburg clear signs will direct you to Koningshof.

By public transport

You can also travel by public transport. At Leiden railway station, take Connexion bus no. 40 (from Leiden to Noordwijk). There is a bus stop a few hundred metres away from Koningshof.

Koningshof is open all the year around, with heated sanitary facilities during the winter time. It is advisable to reserve. Special rates apply during the pre-season and late season and we offer attractive packages for senior citizens and families with small children.

Your own tent or a mobile home from us?

Koningshof measures 19.8 acres which is plenty of space for 175 camping pitches where you can park your caravan or camper van, or put up your tent.

Did you know that you are also welcome to make use of one of the 50 comfortable, fully-furnished mobile homes at attractive locations?

Chalet (5 people): equipped with a living room, two bedrooms, cooking facilities, a bathroom with a shower, toilet and washbasin, a colour television, duvets, tableware, cutlery, pots and pans. A terrace area with garden furniture.

Hikers' cabin (4 people): a cabin equipped with two bunkbeds, pillows, cooking facilities, table and chairs, heating and lighting. Don't forget to bring your own sleeping bags! You can make use of the communal building with sanitary facilities.

Each accommodation facility can be booked by the week, from midweek or for a weekend. The Sunhomes and hikers' cabins can even be rented per night. No pets allowed in the rented accommodation.

Hikers and cyclists who are passing through can put up their tents in yet another area of Koningshof, or they can opt for renting a hikers' cabin.

If you prefer privacy and a bit of luxury, you can always reserve a 'superpitch', which offers even more space, plus electricity, cable television, water and sewage connections. Optimum privacy guaranteed on your own pitch.
